Subject: Orders of significant agreement's value

Legal basis: Article 56(1) point 2 of the Act on Public Offering – Current and Periodic Information

Report content:

The Management Board of ARCUS S.A. hereby informs that on 29 December 2011 received an information that within business cooperation with PRAXIS S.A. (with its registered office in Warsaw, Równoległa 9A Street) based on the framework agreement (regarding the sale of office equipment and consumables) concluded in 2001 for an indefinite period of time, the sales value arising from aforementioned agreement amounted to PLN 6 155 630 (net amount) in the period between 10 June 2011 and 29 December 2011.

The invoice of 13 July 2011 for PLN 202 999 (net amount) for the sales of consumables for Kyocera Mita printers shall be recognized as the most significant invoice in above mentioned period.

Conditions of agreement shall comply with market standards expected for the execution of such agreements.

Contractual penalties:

In case of payment delays in relation to invoice payment dates, the commercial partner (PRAXIS S.A.) shall pay the statutory interests.

The agreement mentioned above meets the criteria of a significant agreement due to the fact that the total value of orders placed 10 June 2011 and 29 December 2011, exceeded 10% of Company's equity.
